Practice profile

In addition to court work, he has assisted arbitral tribunals and parties in several international arbitration proceedings.

On the criminal side, Cyrus has worked on cases involving drug offences, dishonest offences, driving offences, and violent offences. He has also been involved in cases with less common charges, such as terrorism, child pornography, practising medicine without a certificate, and threats to kill.

Cyrus is fluent in English, Cantonese, and Mandarin, and accepts instructions for hearings conducted in any of these languages. He is also capable of preparing legal documents in both traditional and simplified Chinese.

Selected cases

- ***Huang Tao v CMB Wing Lung Bank*** (HCMP 311/2026): obtained a *Norwich Pharmacal* order for the defendant to disclose certain documents which might show the fraud committed by the alleged wrongdoer, who was a commercial partner of the plaintiff.
- ***Kuang Songsong & Ors v Vfine Info Technology Co., Limited & Ors*** (HCMP 363/2026): obtained leave to serve the defendants out of the jurisdiction in an unfair prejudice petition.

- ***Cheng Kar Yue v Bey Logan*** (HCA 2312/2025): acted for the plaintiff in an application for an *ex parte* injunction to prevent the defendant from approaching the plaintiff.
- ***Minder LLC v Tugu Insurance Company Limited*** (HCA 726/2023): acted for the defendant in a 6-day trial on an insurance policy for an air and land combined cargo transportation from Hong Kong to the United States (led by Colin Wright); pending judgment.
